Worship & Music



Choral and Instrumental Music

Talent: Sing and/or play an instrument as part of Trinity Sunday worship through music. In addition to singing in Sunday worship services, the choir and instrumentalists also present special music offerings during Christmas and Easter.

Time: 1-1/2 hours per Sunday service plus 1 hour of Choir practice on Wednesday evenings (extra time for special music preparation) at 7:00 pm in the sanctuary.

Sound Engineer

Talent: Operate sound board during worship services. (Prior experience with mics and boards is VERY helpful!).

Time: 1-1/2 hours per service

Usher

Talent: Welcome worshipers, distribute bulletins, and collect the offering.

They also help with friendship pads, large print hymnals, counting the offering, tidying up the sanctuary after worship, and other needs that may arise during a service.

Time: 11:00 - 12:45 on one's chosen Sunday each month (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th) or as a last minute fill in.

Liturgist

Talent: Assist the minister with leading worship services, reading from a script provided beforehand.

Time: 15 minutes prep, 1 hour service.

Communion Preparation

Talent: Assist worship committee members in preparation: getting out the serving pieces; transporting elements to sanctuary via cart; placing bread tray, napkins, and chalices of juice on table, and removal (and repacking) after service.

Time: 30 minutes prior to service, 20 minutes after service.

Faith Formation & Christian Education

Worship & Wonder Adult Volunteer

Talent: Supervise, engage and teach when the children leave the worship service after the time with children. All adults must have a background check.

Time: The part of the worship service during which the children leave the sanctuary for the W&W room, and until which time they are safely returned to their parents.

Sunday School Teacher & Alternate Teacher/Assistant

Talent: Prepare lessons, lead the participants in study and prayer, and/or alternate as a teacher or as a facilitator/helper. Background check required if working with children or youth.

Time: Presence for the one hour class and prep time as dictated by plans and needs.

Talent: Prepare, plan of worship/faith experiences, fun activities, arts and crafts, and refreshments/snack supper. Background check required.

Confirmation Class Team Member

Talent: Plan, facilitate the Pastor with ideas, materials, participation in the class and in following the plan of study.

Time: Rotating one hour of Sunday school presence for the 9 months of the school year, and attendance at the visits to churches of different faiths. Assigned covenant partners of each confirmand participant will attend class occasionally and the church visits as well.

Talent: Living Waters provides training at least once a year. It takes a

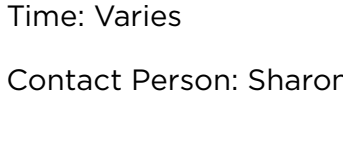
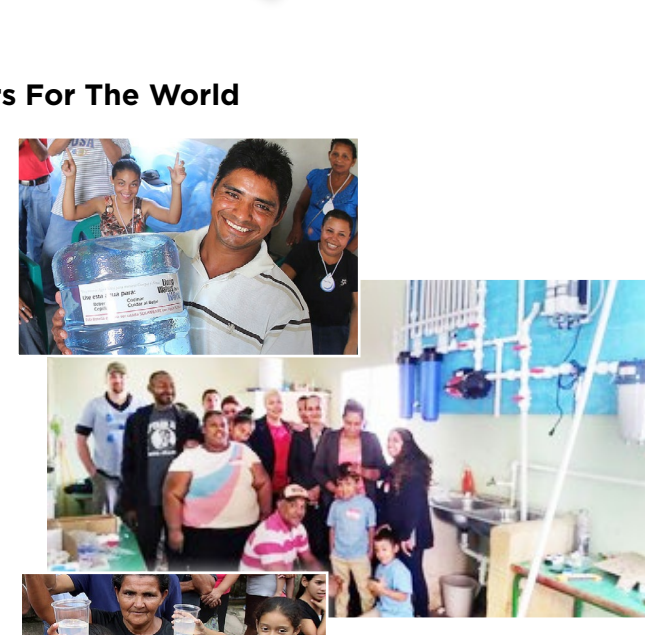
team of 6-8 trained people for an installation to provide clean water to a community in need.
